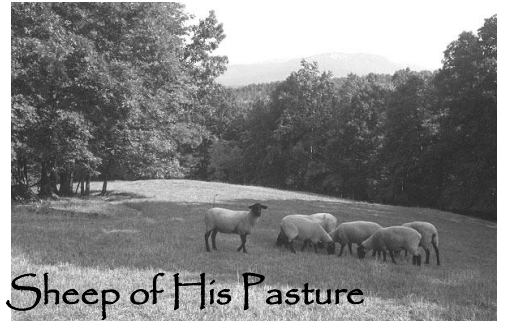

**Scriptural Suicide**

What are the daily responsibilities that God has laid on Christians? It may be shocking to some, but a chief daily responsibility of the Christian is suicide. Obviously I'm not talking about the kind of suicide that Judas Iscariot performed when he hung himself. Rather I'm talking about the kind of suicide that Paul commanded when he wrote, "Put to death, therefore, whatever belongs to your earthly nature: sexual immorality, impurity, lust, evil desires and greed, which is idolatry" (Col. 3:5 NIV).

When a person becomes a Christian, they are "buried with [Christ] through baptism into death" (Rom. 6:4 NIV). This means that the Holy Spirit regenerates the inward person, putting the old sinful self to death, and creating a new person that is alive toward God (i.e., submissive to God's will) (Rom. 6:5-7; cf. Tit. 3:5-7; Eph. 2:10).

Though a person is made holy at the moment of their baptism (1 Cor. 6:11), their holiness is not complete (cf. 2 Cor. 7:1). Christians are called to seek to be holy as God is holy (1 Thess. 4:3; 1 Pet. 1:15-16), but none can claim to be sinless this side of heaven (1 John 1:8, 10). Even after regeneration, remnants of sinfulness remain in the life of the Christian. It is for this reason that Paul exhorts us as follows: "Therefore, brothers and sisters, we have an obligation--but it is not to the flesh, to live according to it. for if you live according to the flesh, you will die; but if by the Spirit you put to death the misdeeds of the body, you will live" (Rom. 8:12-13 NIV).

Thus every day of the Christian's life, they are to die ever more fully to iniquity and to be made ever more alive to God's will.
