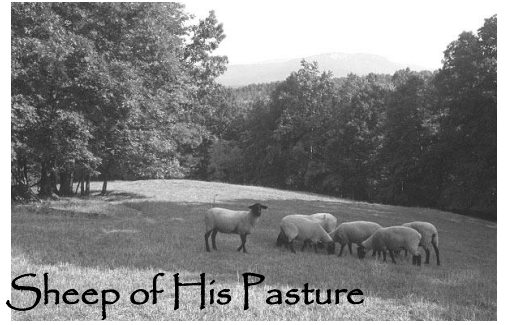

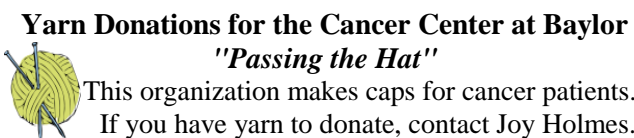
This is a ministry for women to make quilts for those who cannot get out, or are suffering from serious illnesses, to show them that we love them and are thinking of them.

## THINGS THAT STING

Memorial Day was the unofficial start of summer, and it also marks the beginning of stinging season. As a kid I was stung a couple of times every summer, and my dad always put tobacco from his cigarettes on the sting to draw out the poison. The Bible says a good bit about things that sting.

**The Judgment of Hornets:** The land of Canaan was taken from the seven pagan nations because of their sin and given to Israel (Deut. 9:4). The Canaanites' sin defiled them and their land (Lev. 20:24-25). God fought for Israel against the Canaanites in a multitude of ways, including with hailstones (Josh. 10:11). Before Israel arrived, God began to reduce the number of Canaanites by sending on them a plague of hornets; "I sent the hornet ahead of you, which drove them out before you—also the two Amorite kings. You did not do it with your own sword and bow" (Josh. 24:12 NIV).

The hornets testify to the fact that God judges nations (Psa. 94:10). America needs to take heed to this.

**The Blessing of Bees:** God encouraged the Israelites by telling them that Canaan was "not like the land of Egypt, from which [they came], where [they] planted [their] seed and irrigated it by foot as in a vegetable garden" (Deut. 11:10 NIV). Rather, Canaan was "a land flowing with milk and honey" (v. 9 NIV). Since "honey from the comb is sweet to...taste" (Prov. 24:13 NIV), it was considered a luxury (cf. Gen. 43:11; 1 Ki. 14:3). Honey is the product of bees (Jud. 14:8-9). While bees were sometimes considered a judgment like hornets (cf. Isa. 7:18), in this respect they were considered a blessing. The implication of 2 Chronicles 31:5 is that they were domesticated for their honey by the time of Hezekiah.

The bees testify to the fact that God blesses his people with the Promised Land. Imagine what the New Heavens and Earth will be like (2 Pet. 3:13)!

**The Trial of Scorpions:** The sting of most scorpions isn't deadly, but it is very painful (Rev. 9:5). When God called Ezekiel to prophesy to the captive Jews in Babylon, he said, "And you, son of man, do not be afraid of them or their words. Do not be afraid, through briars and thorns are all around you and you live among scorpions. Do not be afraid of what they say or be terrified by them, though they are a rebellious people" (Ezek. 2:6 NIV). Scorpions are a figure of speech to show Ezekiel the difficulty of his calling.

The scorpions testify to the fact that God often tests his people's commitment through hardship (Matt. 13:20-21).
