Narrow Escapes

This world can be a dangerous place. David told Jonathan, "...there is only a step between me and death" (1 Sam. 20:3 NIV).

With death in hot pursuit, many have made narrow escapes. The Bible records three instances when hunted saints had to escape through windows. The king of Jericho sought to capture the Israelite spies sent by Joshua who had taken refuge in Rahab's house. "So she let them down by a rope through the window, for the house she lived in was part of the city wall" (Josh. 2:15 NIV). King Saul's jealousy drove him to seek to kill his son-in-law, David. When Saul sent men by night to David's house, "...Michal let David down through a window, and he escaped" (1 Sam. 19:12 NIV). After Paul's conversion, the Jews of Damascus stirred up the governor to arrest Paul. "But his followers took him by night and lowered him in a basket through an opening (window, 2 Cor. 11:33) in the wall" (Acts 9:25 NIV).

One day God's wrath will be poured out upon creation. Paul said, "The wrath of God is being revealed from heaven against all the godlessness and wickedness of people, who suppress the truth by their wickedness" (Rom. 1:18 NIV). He also wrote, "But because of your stubbornness and your unrepentant heart, you are storing up wrath against yourself for the day of God's wrath, when his righteous judgment will be revealed" (Rom. 2:5 NIV).

However, Christians don't have to fear that day. Paul described the Christian life as follows: "...and to wait for his Son from heaven, whom he raised from the dead--Jesus, who rescues us from the coming wrath" (1 Thess. 1:10 NIV). Our rescue won't be a narrow one through a window. Rather Jesus will rescue us openly, even in front of Satan himself. Paul proclaimed, "For the Lord himself will come down from heaven, with a loud command, with the voice of the archangel and with the trumpet call of God, and the dead in Christ will rise first. After that, we who are still alive and are left will be caught up together with them in the clouds to meet the Lord in the air. And so we will be with the Lord forever" (1 Thess. 4:16-17 NIV).
