How God Views People

Does God view everyone the same, or does God consider some people better than others?

Consider Peter's inspired words at Cornelius's house: "I now realize how true it is that God does not show favoritism but accepts from every nation the one who fears him and does what is right" (Acts 10:34-35 NIV). Peter took a lot of flak from his prejudiced Jewish brothers over his having gone into the Gentile Cornelius's house. But Peter's statement shows that God isn't prejudiced for or against anyone on the basis of their race. However, it also shows that God is concerned with a person's choices and character.

A person can make themselves worse than others by committing more heinous sins. Paul wrote, "Anyone who does not provide for their relatives, and especially for their own household, has denied the faith and is worse than an unbeliever" (1 Tim. 5:8 NIV).

A person can make themselves better than others by righteous behavior. God said to King Saul through Samuel, "The LORD has torn the kingdom of Israel from you today and has given it to one of your neighbors--to one better than you" (1 Sam. 15:28 NIV).

The great news is that God's negative view of a person isn't unchangeably set. Paul, who at one time was a blasphemous murderer, is proof of this. He wrote, "Here is a trustworthy saying that deserves full acceptance: Christ Jesus came into the world to save sinners--of whom I am the worst. But for that very reason I was shown mercy so that in me, the worst of sinners, Christ Jesus might display his immense patience as an example for those who would believe in him and receive eternal life" (1 Tim. 1:15-16 NIV).
