## The World is Watching

Some have accused Houston's Lakewood Church and its pastor, Joel Osteen, of heartless hypocrisy for not providing shelter for Houstonians driven from their homes by floodwaters.

Lakewood Church has denied this allegation. Donald Iloff, church spokesman, said, "We have never closed our doors. We will continue to be a distribution center for those in need. We are prepared to shelter people once the cities and county shelters reach capacity. Lakewood will be a value to the community in the aftermath of this storm in helping our fellow citizens rebuild their lives."

The church's denial hasn't stopped people from criticizing them. One person tweeted, "It is easier for a camel to go through the eye of a needle, than for a flood victim to enter Joel Osteen's church." Leslie Kahn tweeted, "Always knew Joel Osteen was fraud & shyster. Not offering shelter in Houston to those who made him a millionaire. See him for who he is."

I have no idea as to what exactly happened, nor am I interested in acting as Lakewood's or Osteen's press secretary. However, this incident should make something very clear to us: The world doesn't like those who confess Christ; and it is looking for anything about which to criticize them.

The situation has always been like this. That is why Peter gave the following exhortations, "Live such good lives among the pagans that, though they accuse you of doing wrong, they may see your good deeds and glorify God on the day he visits us"; and, "For it is God's will that by doing good you should silence the ignorant talk of foolish people" (1 Pet. 2:12, 15 NIV).
