"Make Yourself Useful"

We've all probably been told, "Make yourself useful," at a time when we were just standing around, and maybe were in the way. The Bible commands us to make ourselves useful in so many words.

A child of God can be spiritually useless. Jesus taught, "You are the salt of the earth. But if the salt loses its saltiness, how can it be made salty again? It is no longer good for anything, except to be thrown out and trampled underfoot" (Matt. 5:13 NIV). The Jews who survived the siege of Jerusalem in 586 B.C., and who were subsequently taken into Babylonian Exile are concrete examples of those who are spiritually useless. God likened them to a charred branch from a grapevine. He asked, "Son of man, how is the wood of a vine different from that of a branch from any of the trees in the forest? Is wood ever taken from it to make anything useful? Do they make pegs from it to hang things on? And after it is thrown on the fire as fuel and the fire burns both ends and chars the middle, is it then useful for anything? If it was not useful for anything when it was whole, how much less can it be made into something useful when the fire has burned it and it is charred?" (Ezek. 15:2-5 NIV).

Faith in Christ should make one useful to God and man. The Letter to Philemon is about a runaway slave named Onesimus, who was converted to Christ by Paul in Rome and who was subsequently sent back to his Christian master, Philemon. The name Onesimus means "useful," and Paul made a play on this meaning, writing, "Formerly he was useless to you, but now he has become useful both to you and to me" (verse 11 NIV). While Onesimus was a sinner, he was useless to Philemon and to God, as his illegal running away manifested. However, his conversion to Christ made him useful as a good worker both in secular and spiritual matters.

Though we should consider our usefulness in every area of our lives, let's focus on our usefulness in the church. Let's each ask ourselves this question: If I were taken from Meadow View, what impact would that have on the church? Have I made myself useful?
