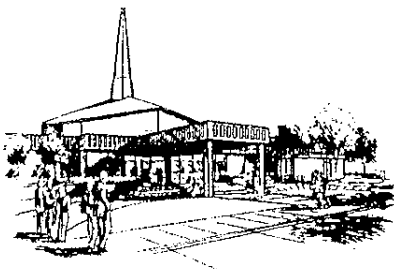

Cling to Him

On Saturday, January 26, Richard Kamrowski and Mark Fitzgerald got into a minor wreck on the Massachusetts Turnpike. When they pulled over to exchange information, they got into an argument. The 36-year-old Fitzgerald got into his SUV to leave, but the 65-year-old Kamrowski jumped onto the hood of the SUV. Fitzgerald drove for 3 miles at speeds of up to 70 miles per hour with Kamrowski clinging to the hood. Finally, Fitzgerald was persuaded to pull over by another driver who was pointing a gun at him.

When the Massachusetts State Police arrived, they arrested both men. Kamrowski was charged with disorderly conduct, and Fitzgerald was charged with assault with a deadly weapon, negligent driving and leaving the scene of an accident.

In an interview, Kamrowski, the man clinging to hood of the SUV, said, "I thought he was going to run over me and I don't know I don't think he stopped. He just kept going fast then slow, fast then slow trying to get me to slide off, and I wasn't getting off the car."

Can you imagine how tightly you would cling to the hood if the car to which it were attached were going 70 miles per hour down the highway? It would be suicide to let go. Actually, in life we should be clinging even more tightly to our God. Connection with him is our only hope of life.

As Israel was preparing to enter Canaan, where the natives served many false gods, Moses challenged them again and again, "...Now choose life, so that you and your children may live and that you may love the Lord your God, listen to his voice, and hold fast to him. For the Lord is your life, and he will give you many years in the land he swore to give to your fathers, Abraham, Isaac and Jacob" (Deut. 30:19-20 NIV).

Though many Israelites often let go of God so that they might seek after false gods, David clung to him. He wrote, "You, God, are my God, earnestly I seek you; I thirst for you, my whole being longs for you, in a dry and parched land where there is no water...I cling to you; your right hand upholds me" (Psa. 63:1, 8 NIV).
