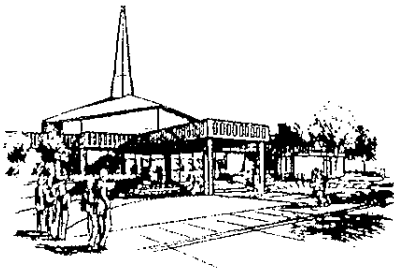

A Link to the Past

John Tyler was the tenth President of the United States. He was elected as the Vice President of William Henry Harrison. But when Harrison died in April 1841, just one month into his term, Tyler became President. John Tyler is the President who was responsible for the annexation of Texas into the United States.

Amazingly, though President John Tyler was born in 1790 and died in 1862, he has two grandsons who are still alive! Here is how.

John Tyler's first wife, Letitia, died in September 1842, while he was President. He was the first President to marry while in office. He married Julia, who was 30 years his junior, in June 1844. John and Julia had seven children together, one of whom was Lyon. Lyon was born in 1853, when his father was 63 years old.

Lyon's first wife, Anne, died in 1921. In 1923, Lyon married Sue Ruffin, who was 35 years his junior. Lyon, Jr. was born to the couple in 1924, and Harrison was born in 1928. At the time of Harrison's birth, Lyon, Sr. was 75 years old!

At the time of the writing of this article, Lyon, Jr. and Harrison are still alive! These two men are basically only two generations removed from the founding of our country. When their grandfather was born, George Washington was less than a year into his first term as President!

While it is amazing to think of the link to the past that these two men have, being grandchildren of the tenth US President, it is even more amazing to think of our link through our heavenly Father. You see, God has no grandchildren, only children (Gal. 3:26-27; 4:6). Psalm 90:2 says of our Father, "Before the mountains were born or you brought forth the whole world, from everlasting to everlasting you are God" (NIV). As God's children, we're only one generation removed from eternity past.
