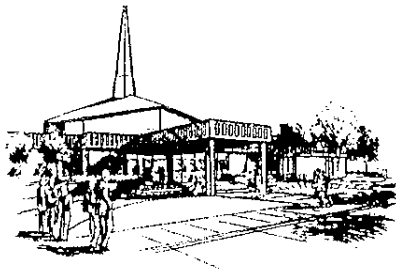

Ladies Ministry - ICU Care Bags

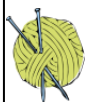
