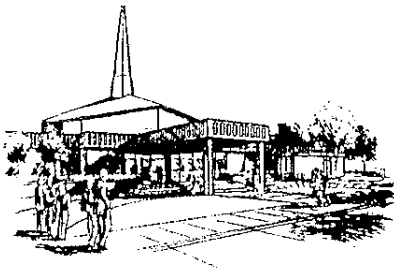

Ladies Ministry - ICU Care Bags

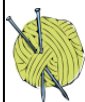

Distraction

The Chisago County Sheriff's Department, just north of Minneapolis, Minnesota, reported an unusual traffic stop. Sergeant Jason Foster pulled over a driver who was having a hard time staying in his lane. When the officer approached the vehicle, the reason for the erratic driving was immediately apparent; the driver had a pig sitting on his lap. Actually, he had two pigs sitting on his lap, the larger of the two weighing 250-pounds!

The driver claimed that he was moving across the state and had the pigs on his lap because he didn't want them to get cold. Sergeant Foster let him off with just a warning.

Distracted driving can be very dangerous, but distracted living can be even more dangerous!

Jesus described such by the thorny soil in The Parable of the Sower. He said, "Still others, like seed sown among thorns, hear the word; but the worries of this life, the deceitfulness of wealth and the desires for other things come in and choke the word, making it unfruitful" (Mark 4:18-19 NIV). The things that distract us from obeying God's word often seem so important. Think about the things about which we worry--job problems, family problems, health problems, car problems, etc. These are all legitimate concerns. However, we must never allow them to become such distractions that we neglect to obey God's will for our lives.
