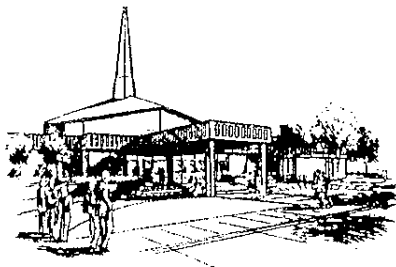

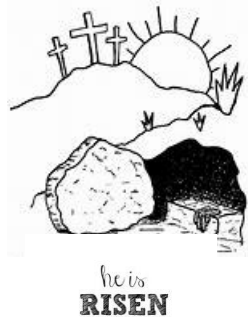

Ladies Ministry - ICU Care Bags

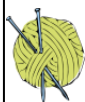

The Church Cannot Be Destroyed

A very sad thing happened last Monday. The Notre Dame Cathedral burned. This historic structure, which sits on an island in the middle of the Seine River in Paris, was constructed between 1160 and 1260. It is a defining part of the Parisian skyline and is the most visited tourist site in the city.

Beginning at about 6:20 p.m. Paris time, the fire blazed for five hours. The 800-year-old, dry oak and chestnut beams that make up the structure proved to be extremely flammable. About two-thirds of the roof is gone, including the iconic spire. The initial report as of the writing of this article is that overall Notre Dame is structurally sound.

While earthly buildings in which churches meet may be burned into non-existence, the church that the Cosmic Carpenter built cannot (Matt. 16:18; cf. Mark 6:3; John 1:3). It is of this church that the Hebrews' writing was referring to when he exhorted, "Therefore, since we are receiving a kingdom that cannot be shaken, let us be thankful, and so worship God acceptably with reverence and awe" (Heb. 12:28 NIV; cf. v. 23).

Individual congregations of the church that Christ built may so fall away from his instructions that they cease to be his (Rev. 2:1-5). Also, this apostasy can spread to other congregations so that large numbers of local churches cease to be recognized by him. However, since a local church is established when two people, having heard and obeyed the gospel, begin to meet together for worship according to the New Testament pattern, then as long as the New Testament exists the church cannot be destroyed.
