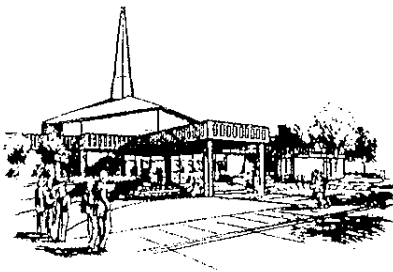

Ladies Ministry - ICU Care Bags

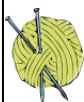

"I Don't Think That I'm Up to It"

Solomon was probably about 20 years old when he became the king of Israel. While he was in Gibeon offering sacrifices, God spoke to him in a dream. "Ask for whatever you want me to give you," God said (1 Ki. 3:5 NIV). Solomon requested, "Now, LORD my God, you have made your servant king in place of my father David. But I am only a little child and do not know how to carry out my duties...Give your servant a discerning heart to govern your people and to distinguish between right and wrong. For who is able to govern this great people of yours?" (1 Ki. 3:7, 9 NIV). Solomon did not feel up to the task that God had assigned to him, and so he used his "one wish" to ask for the ability necessary to govern well. God was pleased with Solomon's prayer and granted him the wisest heart of any person outside of Jesus (1 Ki. 3:12).

Just as God placed an enormous responsibility upon Solomon's shoulders in making him king, so he has placed great responsibilities upon us. He has called some of us to rear children and grandchildren in his way (Prov. 22:6; Eph. 6:4). God commands us to carry the gospel to all of the lost in all of the world (Matt. 28:18-20). The Chief Shepherd has appointed some of us elders with the task of watching over his flock (1 Pet. 5:1-4). The Almighty has providentially assigned some of us to positions of secular responsibility in which others are dependent upon us for their livelihood (cf. Col. 4:1). When you have looked at your assigned task, have you ever felt like Solomon did? Have you ever felt that you were not up to it?

We have all probably felt overwhelmed by the responsibilities which rest on our shoulders. However, we have in biblical stories like this one about Solomon's dream an implicit promise: What God calls a person to do, he will enable that person to do (cf. Jer. 1:6-8).

What would you do if God said to you what he did to Solomon, "Ask for whatever you want me to give to you"? Actually, he has said this to us. Jesus said, "Ask and it will be given to you" (Matt. 7:7 NIV). If we will ask him to give us wisdom to fulfill these tasks that he has by providence assigned to us, God will grant it to us as he did to Solomon. Remember what James wrote: "If any of you lacks wisdom, you should ask God, who gives generously to all without finding fault, and it will be given to you" (1:5 NIV).
