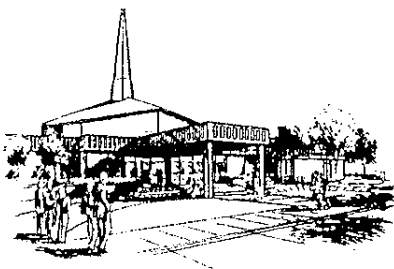

### Ladies Ministry - ICU Care Bags

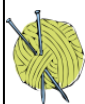

## FIGHTS

It was reported last week that Vanna White had claimed that she and Pat Sajak had only had one fight in their time together on Wheel of Fortune. Though they have worked together for over 36 years and have made over 7,000 episodes of the game show, White said, "Believe it or not, Pat Sajak and I have only had one fight in 36 years and that was over putting ketchup on a hot dog." Apparently, White likes both ketchup and mustard on hot dogs but Sajak likes only mustard. Of course, Pat Sajak won that fight!

A good question for us to ask ourselves is this: Am I as agreeable with the people who are close to me as Vanna White and Pat Sajak are with one another? As Christians, we are supposed to be. Paul wrote, "Live in harmony with one another...If it is possible, as far as it depends on you, live at peace with one another...Accept one whose faith is weak, without quarreling over disputable matters...Let us therefore make every effort to do what leads to peace and to mutual edification" (Rom. 12:16, 18; 14:1, 19 NIV).

What are some things that will help us not to stir up fights?

-Don't wear your feelings on your sleeve: "Fools show their annoyance at once, but the prudent overlook an insult" (Prov. 12:16 NIV).

-Don't always demand to be right: "Where there is strife, there is pride, but wisdom is found in those who take advice" (Prov. 13:10 NIV).

-Control your temper: "A hot-tempered person stirs up conflict, but the one who is patient calms a quarrel" (Prov. 15:18 NIV).

-Be wise with your words: "The lips of fools bring them strife, and their mouths invite a beating" (Prov. 18:6 NIV).

Let's be sure that people don't think of us the way that the Psalmist described people around him; "Too long have I lived among those who hate peace. I am for peace; but when I speak, they are for war" (Psa. 120:6-7 NIV).
