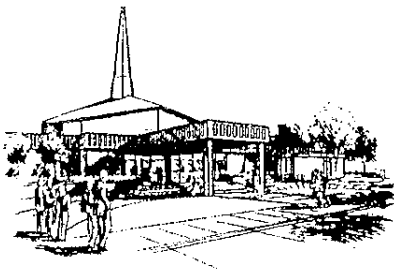

**Ladies Ministry - ICU Care Bags**

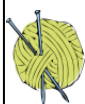

**WAITING FOR THE ACTION**

I read an interesting statistic recently. An article in The Wall Street Journal claimed that during a three-hour baseball game there is only about 18 minutes of action. Thus most of the time that one is watching a baseball game they are waiting for something to happen.

The Wall Street Journal's assessment of baseball is really a pretty good description of how life seems to be. The vast majority of life is boring. It is routine. It is repetitious. But every once in a while something really exciting happens. That something may be either good or bad. However, most days end just as they began. The chronic routine of life can be depressing. Some people even forsake their commitments seeking adventure.

Jesus' teaching on the final judgment found in Matthew 25:31-46 shows that, on that very exciting day which will end all days, Jesus will reward us according to our response to seemingly mundane things. Most of us don't see our interaction with a needy brother or sister as a very exciting thing. We wouldn't consider it to be the action that we're waiting for. However, Jesus identifies with the needy saint and views our treatment of them as our treatment of him. All of us would view meeting Jesus face to face as very exciting. We all have met him in our spiritual siblings.

Here is the point: Never view an act of Christian service as mundane. It may not seem as exciting as an invitation to the governor's mansion. However, the last day will reveal it to be infinitely more consequential.
