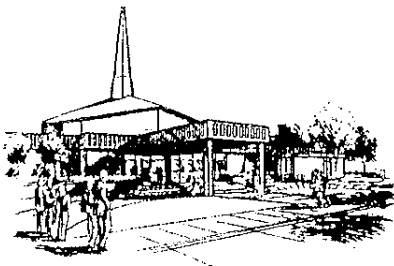

**Ladies Ministry - ICU Care Bags**

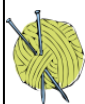

**LEARNING FROM MISTAKES**

Robert Kiyosaki, author of "Rich Dad Poor Dad," said, "Don't waste a good mistake...Learn from it." This is the point of Hebrews 12:11: "No discipline seems pleasant at the time, but painful. Later on, however, it produces a harvest of righteousness and peace for those who have been trained by it" (NIV). The progression of thought in this verse is as follows: a) Our sin; b) God's discipline; c) We're trained by the discipline not to commit that sin any longer; d) We act righteously.

Eleanor Roosevelt is reported to have said, "Learn from the mistakes of others. You can't live long enough to make them all yourself." The Bible exhorts us to learn what we should do from the positive examples of righteous people (Heb. 13:7), but it also encourages us to learn what we should not do from the negative examples of wicked people (Jude 7).

Consider what Paul wrote in 1 Corinthians. Sandwiched in between Paul's statement about his own efforts to avoid becoming a rejected apostate (9:24-27) and his warnings against idolatry which stirs up God's jealous anger (10:14-22), Paul brings up the example of the Israelites in the wilderness (10:1-13). Paul tells how they were baptized in the Red Sea to become God's people (1-2) and were supernaturally cared for in the barren desert by Christ (3-4). However, he brings up four examples of the Israelites' sins in the wilderness that kept them out of the Promised Land (7-10). Paul bookended his account of their sins with these words: "Now these things occurred as examples to keep us from setting our hearts on evil things as they did...These things happened to them as examples and were written down as warning for us, on whom the culmination of the ages has come (6, 11 NIV).

We certainly should learn from our own sins. But isn't it better to learn from the sins of others so as not to have to suffer ourselves? "Flog a mocker, and the simple will learn prudence...When a mocker is punished, the simple gain wisdom" (Prov. 19:25; 21:11 NIV).
