

### The Billy Graham Rule' Demeans Women?

Regardless of what one may think of Billy Graham's theology, he finished his earthly race without tarnishing his reputation as a good, moral man. One of the 'rules' that Graham personally followed to avoid temptation and scandal was that he would never dine alone with a woman who wasn't his wife.

Robert Foster is a State Representative in Mississippi and is currently running for governor of that state. He is now under fire because Larrison Campbell, a political reporter for Mississippi Today, was denied her request to a ride along interview unless she could get one of her male colleagues to accompany them. The ride along interview would have been 15-16 hours in Foster's personal vehicle. He said that since his campaign was short-handed, he couldn't provide one of his staffers to go with them.

Rep. Foster said that he and his wife had agreed to follow The Billy Graham Rule so that neither would ever have cause to question the other's fidelity to their marriage vows. Ms. Campbell, however, claims that Foster is actually a sexist. She said in a CNN interview, "It's sexism. Look we've got to call this what it is. When a woman isn't given access to the same things that a man is given access to, it's sexism."

The Washington Post didn't have any better things to say about Rep. Foster's commitment to The Billy Graham Rule. It quoted Jeremy White as follows: "[The rule] presumes either: A) you can't be trusted or B) women can't be trusted. Everyone invoking that rule should be prepared to answer which is true." Keep in mind that this critique comes on the heels of the Kavanaugh hearing, in which Christine Blasey Ford accused Kavanaugh of sexually assaulting her though she couldn't remember any of the details or offer any proof. Many people believed Ford just because she claimed to be a victim.

The Billy Graham Rules doesn't seem either to demean women or to imply the personal depravity of its practitioner. Rather, it seems to uphold twin biblical commands: "So, if you think you are standing firm, be careful that you don't fall" (1 Cor. 10:12 NIV), and "Be careful to do what is right in the eyes of everyone" (Rom. 12:17 NIV). The later of these two commands, however, has seemingly become impossible to fulfill. Jesus description of his generation is appropriate for ours. "To what can I compare this generation? They are like children sitting in the marketplaces and calling out to the others: 'We played the pipe for you, and you did not dance; we sang a dirge, and you did not mourn'" (Matt. 11:16-17 NIV). That is, they constantly change the rules and can't be pleased.
