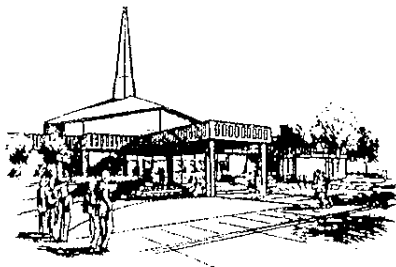

## SECRET MESSAGE?

The Central Intelligence Agency of the United States stirred up Twitter on August 29. It tweeted a picture of a toast between a Starbucks Pumpkin Spice Latte and a Dunkin' Donuts Pumpkin Latte. The picture had this caption: "We know it's not fall yet... but we're in the business of anticipating things before they happen. #PSL@Starbucks @dunkindonuts."

This cryptic post left many wondering if it was just a celebration of a seasonal favorite, or if there was some hidden message contained in the tweet.

Hidden messages are nothing new in the secret affairs of nations. When Jonathan was arranging with David about how to communicate to him whether his father, king Saul, was seeking to kill him or not, he arranged this secret message (1 Sam. 20). He had David hide behind a particular rock (v. 19). Jonathan would then target practice and have a boy to retrieve his arrows (vv. 20-21). If Jonathan said to the boy, "Look, the arrows are on this side of you," then David was to know that he was safe and that Saul wasn't seeking to kill him (v. 21 NIV). However, if Jonathan said to the boy, "Look, the arrows are beyond you," then David was to know that he needed to flee because Saul was after him (v. 22 NIV).

Thankfully, we don't have to depend upon the ability to decipher secret messages in order to determine God's will for our lives. God communicates his message to us using straightforward language. Consider these statements from Paul:

"For we do not write you anything you cannot read or understand" (2 Cor. 1:13 NIV).

"In reading this, then, you will be able to understand my insight into the mystery of Christ" (Eph. 3:4 NIV).

"Therefore, do not be foolish, but understand what the Lord's will is" (Eph. 5:17 NIV).
