- 06/06/17 Creator**

- 07/04/17 Truth**
 There are many conflicting beliefs being presented in our society. Relativism and postmodernism falls short. There is no ultimate hope without God. God is the definition of morality and the supreme truth. Teens do not need to lean on their own understanding but on the Lord.
- 07/11/17 Powerful**
 God is bigger than we can ever imagine. The purpose of the unknown universe is to show that God is greater than the physical universe. No problem or sin is too great for the Lord. He is above all!
- 07/18/17 Love**
 God is synonymous with love. He is the prime example on how to love others. Love does not just mean tolerance without boundaries. Love means caring for the person, but not always approving of actions. Love demands action. Teens must understand that to love the Lord means to obey His commandments.
